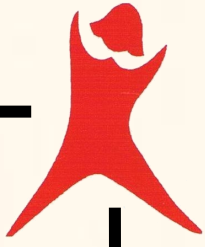

used in a MUN. A mock session was conducted to at the end of the workshop to assess our learning. In spite of having had this workshop for the first time in our school , it was a great success!



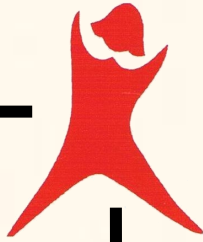
LEADERSHIP WORKSHOP

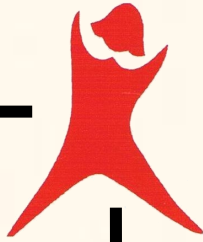
COMMERCE TRIP

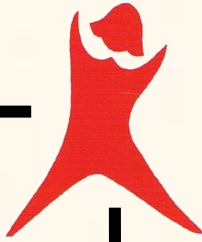
SCIENCE TRIP

ANTI-BULLYING WHETSTONE



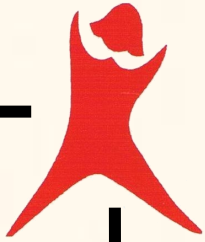
The Anti Bullying Week was started with a whetstone GEP "Reign Of Rein."
