Hopetown Girls' School will be administering the SAT exam on **2nd October 2021**. The guidelines for our center are listed below. We will appreciate if all guidelines are followed **STRICTLY** which will enable us to administer the exam smoothly. For further queries, please reach us at collegeboard@hopetown.co.in

Guidelines:

- 1. Candidates who are travelling from outside of Dehradun on 2nd October 2021 will need to produce RTPCR COVID-19 Test report(72 hrs prior). Entry will be not permitted without the negative report. You are also requested to check state guidelines before planning to travel to the state of Uttarakhand.
- 2. Candidates must report to the center by 8:00 am. The gates will close at 8:30 AM
- **3.** All candidates will have to fill the self-declaration form before the exam date.
- 4. Only students will be allowed to enter the school campus; parents/guardians are requested to drop the students and leave the campus.
- 5. No waiting/ parking of vehicles will be allowed outside the gate.
- 6. Parents should pick the student from outside the school gate after the end of the examination.
- 7. Candidates will queue up and get a temperature check before entering the campus.
- 8. Only Admission tickets, Passports /Aadhar cards, Pencil boxes, and calculators will be allowed inside the examination rooms.
- 9. Candidates should bring their Masks, Sanitizers, Face Shield & Surface cleaning spray for their safety.
- 10. Candidates are advised to bring their own water bottles & dry snacks.
- 11. **NO MOBILES & Smartwatches** will be allowed inside the campus. There is no provision to deposit your mobile phones therefore kindly leave them with your parents/guardians.
- 12. Candidates must carry their Passport/Aadhar Card in original and a photocopy for identification purposes.
- 13. Teachers & candidates will have to wear N95/Triple layered Cotton/ surgical masks for the entire duration of the exam.
- 14. Students to always maintain 6 feet distance between one another during their stay on campus.
- 15. All students and staff must follow the sanitization process at the gate.
- 16. Please use the hand sanitizer placed at the gate & outside the examination rooms.
- 17. No gathering of students will be allowed in the hallways during the breaks.
- 18. Candidates will have access only to the examination area and will not be allowed to roam on campus.
- 19. During exam breaks, students will be allowed to go to the washroom in a staggered manner.
- 20. If any candidate fails to meet the temperature check, he/ she will not be allowed to sit for the examination.
- 21. Please produce the original hard copy of your Hall Tickets when required.
