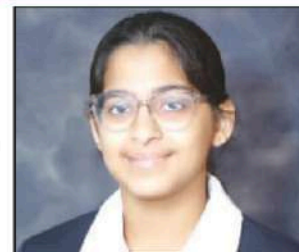

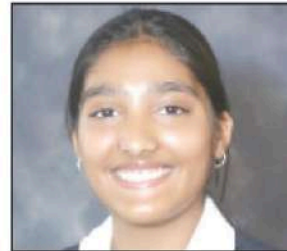

Dear Parents,

Greetings from Hopetown Girls' School!

I know that many of you experienced uncertainty and anxiety due to the political situation, and I just want to say that you all were in our thoughts during those challenging times. I am hoping that this is now behind us, allowing us to look forward to peaceful days ahead.

Although May was a short academic month, it was brimming with outstanding achievements by our students. Our girls made us proud at both the ICSE and ISC levels. Our Yoga team displayed remarkable skill at the State-Level Yoga Competition, where they bagged 2 gold and 8 silver prizes. They also secured first prize in the CISCE Yoga Competition. 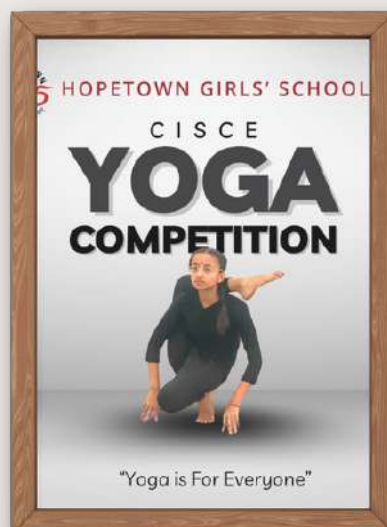

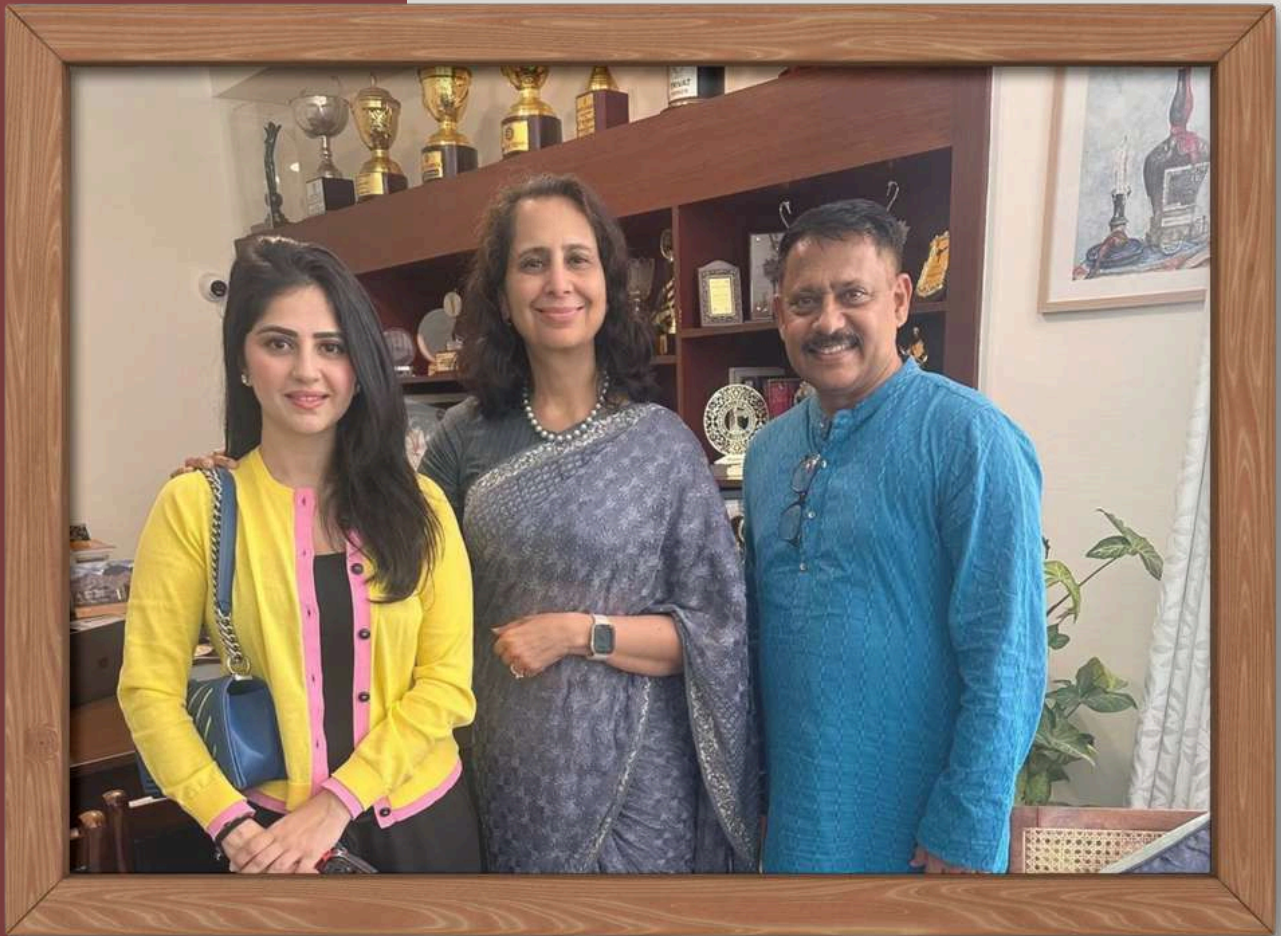
